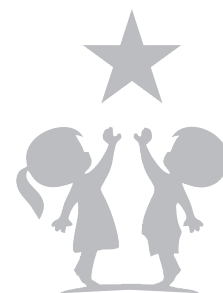

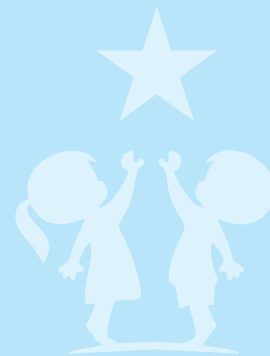

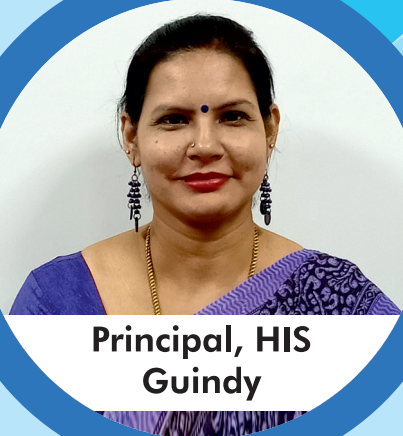

To Facilitate the natural all round development process of a Pre School Child and ensure a smooth transition into the Pre Primary School Environment.

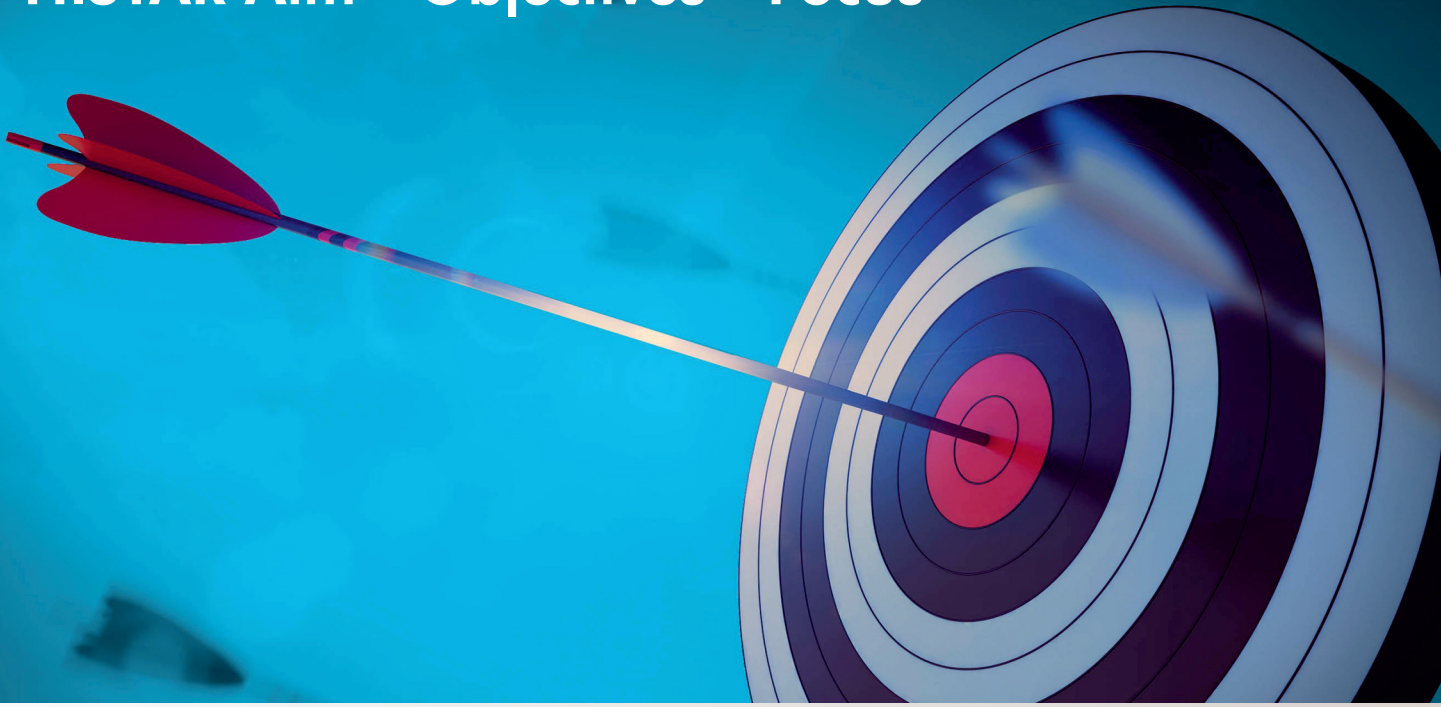
## Mission

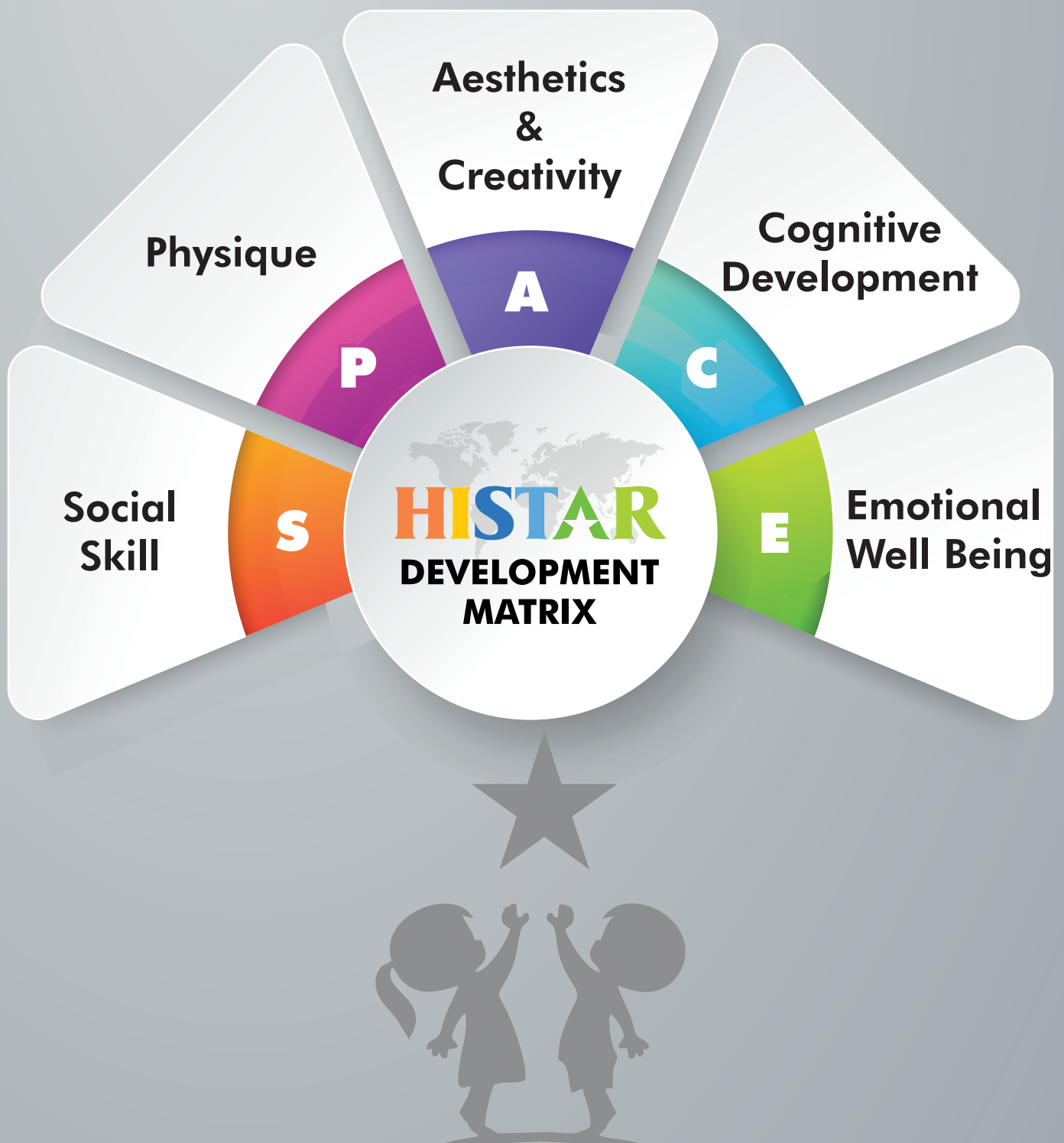
## **Objectives of HISTAR**

# The HISTAR Programme

The Focus of The HISTAR Programme is to facilitate the balanced and All Round Development of the Child in the domains of Social Skills, Physique, Aesthetics and Creativity and Cognitive & Emotional Development.

## Social Skills

- To Nurture Children to be Sociable and behave in an appropriate and desirable manner. It includes the ability to interact with Adults and Peers.

## Physique

- To facilitate the development of Children's Gross and Fine Motor Skills .
- To improve their Sensory Perceptions and ability of Concentration and Observation.
- To enable Children to develop Awareness for Self Protection.

## Aesthetics and Creativity

- To enrich Children's Sensory Experiences and encourage them to freely express their Thoughts and Feelings.
- To Stimulate Children's Creativity and Imagination and encourage them to enjoy participating in Creative Works and Activity.

## Cognitive and Language Development

- To arouse and fulfil the curiosity of Children and cultivate in them an Inquisitive Mind.
- To develop simple Logical Concepts and basics of Numeracy and Literacy.
- To develop abilities in Analysis, Reasoning, Judgement and Problem Solving.

## Emotional Well Being and Development

- Young Children learn to adapt to the existence of Emotions - Joy, Pain, Anger through everyday experiences. This domain includes the development of Self Confidence and Self Esteem. This learning domain includes the ability to express Feelings and Emotions without inhibitions.



# Parent Collaboration Model (PCM)

- It is a well established fact that very significant Cognitive Development of a Child takes place in the Pre School years.
- Parents who are fully in sync with Pre School Events and Programmes are better poised to establish an appropriate connect between what is learnt at School and what takes place at Home.
- The HISTAR Programme envisages deep and extensive contact with our Parents to monitor the development of the Child and behaviour while not in School.
- Positive Parental Participation necessitates that a Child's Learning is a 24 X 7 Continuous Learning Process. This facilitates the Synaptic Brain Development Process of the Child significantly and facilitates subsequent Cognitive Development.
- Enhanced Parental Participation is ensured through a regular written and spoken Feedback System involving all aspects of the Child's Learning Process.
- Parental Support is the Pivot to ensure that there is absolute Congruence and Synergy on what is practiced both at Home and School to ensure that the Child faces no childhood dilemma on what is taught and what is actually practised.



# Development Review Matrix (DRM)

## Basis of Development Review Matrix

In keeping with the concept of Learning through Fun, the HISTAR Programme does not envisage any Formal Assessment of the Child. The DRM hinges on continuous evaluation of a Child's Progress. Every Child has his/her own pace of development and this important fact needs to be kept in mind while reviewing the Child's Development.

The HISTAR Programme reviews the development of a Child vis-a-vis his/her own progressive benchmark and is an indicator of the individual Child's progress and not a comparison with other Children.

## Aim

To enable Teachers to determine if Teaching Strategies and Activities are reflecting the desired results and reformulate methodology where needed to achieve desired objectives.

## Assessment Strategies

- Observation and Learning Log
- Recording the progress of Learning Objectives and Characteristics
- Periodic Review Meetings with Students and Parents
- Informal/Casual Demonstration of Skills by the Students
- One on One Interaction (Question & Answer Method)

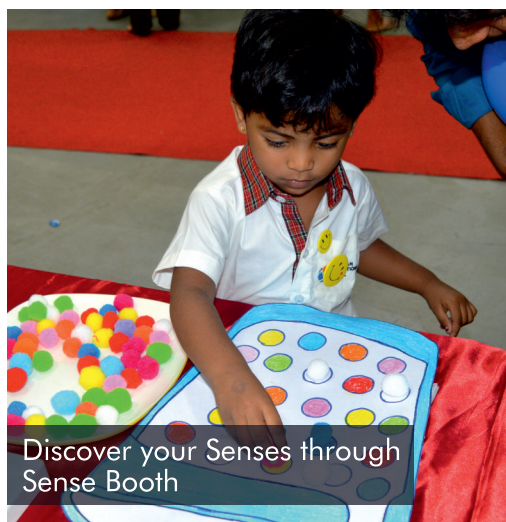
